Our school strategies are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2015, we have focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our *Great Results Guarantee* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our strategies to ensure that every student succeeds.

Strategies implemented include:

- Research into student friendly criteria sheets and Action Research Project for improving writing outcomes
- Using diagnostic reading tests to identify student issues
- Providing reading programs such as Toe by Toe and Multilit to improve student outcomes
- Developing Skills Lessons for Numeracy and Literacy
- Professional development for teachers in a range of areas including reading, explicit teaching and differentiation
- Teacher coaching by Master Teacher

Achievements:

Writing:

- Yr 7 – increased the number of students in the M2B (28%) and U2B (25%) = 53%
- Yr 8 - increased the number of students significantly in both M2B and U2B
- Yr 9 – Increased the number of students in both M2B and U2B to 57.5%

Reading:

- Yr 7 – Increased students in the M2B to 49% exceeding the target by 9%
- Yr 8 – increased students in the U2B to 20% exceeding the target by 2%
- Yr 9 – Increased students in the M2B to 47% exceeding the target by 1%

Numeracy:

- Yr 7 – Decreased Band 3 scores from 22% to 10% exceeding the target by 9%
- Yr 8 – increased students in M2B 65% exceeding the target by 13%
- Yr 9 – Increased students in Band 7, as well as in U2B to 35%
